Subject: **Revised Curriculum for Degree Programs in Computer Science**

Ref: Reference to HEC letter No. HEC/NCRC/CS&IT/2025/8163 dated October 14, 2025, and letter No. HEC/Curri/CS-IT/2025/8421 dated December 3, 2025, regarding the subject cited above

Honorable Sir/Madam,


The Higher Education Commission (HEC) has revised the BS Computer Science curriculum in 2025 and has directed its implementation. In this regard, all HEIs/DAIs are required to adhere to the HEC directives and implement the revised curriculum in letter and spirit not later than Fall 2026.

Please note that in accordance with the provision on page 19 of the revised curriculum, HEIs/DAIs are permitted to maintain specialized computing programs as separate degrees under the BS Computing Curricula 2023 until these are superseded.

“Note: The universities who intend to continue the existing programs of BS Computing Specialization degrees other than BS Computer Science are allowed to continue and get accreditation from NCEAC, however such degrees shall not be considered equivalent to BS Computer Science.”

NCEAC appreciates your cooperation and continued support in ensuring the timely and effective implementation of the revised national curriculum standards for Computing Programs across all higher education institutions in Pakistan.
