Agenda Item no. 1 Acknowledgement of services of ex-chairman

The Council acknowledged the services of its ex-chairman Dr. Aftab Ahmed. The text of the resolution is given below:

National Computing Education Accreditation Council (NCEAC) was established by Higher Education Commission (HEC) in 2005. Dr Aftab Ahmad was appointed by HEC as its first Chairperson for a term of four years. His appointment was extended for another term of four years in 2009 and then again in 2013. Although his term had not expired, but due to his health problems, he resigned from this position on 13th October 2015.

NCEAC was the first such council established by the HEC. Hence there was no role model which could be followed. Everything had to be conceived and developed from scratch. Dr Aftab and his colleagues in the NCEAC worked tirelessly to come up with a working model, which is not only being followed to date, but was also a role model for other councils, which were established afterwards by the HEC.

The Council would like to record its appreciation for the valuable and unforgettable services rendered by Dr Aftab Ahmad, the former Chairperson of NCEAC.

Dr. Aftab Ahmad motivated the universities to seek accreditation from NCEAC with a view to improve quality of computing education in the country. Due to efforts of his team and his constant guidance, NCEAC has so far accredited 214 computing programs, while 16 more are in the pipeline.

NCEAC will always remember his efforts for the betterment of computing education in Pakistan.

Agenda Item no. 6 Registration of IT Professionals

The Council noted that this matter has been pending for quite some time with little or no progress. After appointment of a new Chairperson of the Council, **it was decided to re-constitute the committee with the following members:**

- 1. Dr Arshad Ali Shahid**
- 2. Dr Mansoor Sarwar**
- 3. Dr M. Ayub Alvi**

The committee shall present its progress in the next meeting of the Council. Following were proposed regarding registration of IT students and professionals:

1. If required, a working paper should be prepared and submitted to HEC for approval.
2. Propose an appropriate name for this body (e.g. Computing Professionals body)
3. Each University requesting accreditation of its computing program shall be required to submit list of **ALL** students registered in that program (Student Name, Father Name, CNIC number, batch, semester, and program of study). Thus a database of all students registered in computing degree programs shall be developed.
4. Similarly, each University shall be asked to provide information about the faculty involved in teaching computing related courses (Name of Faculty, Father's Name, CNIC number, etc.). This should help create database of all computing faculty.
5. All students enrolled in an accredited program shall be registered as Student Members of Computing Professionals Body
6. Graduates of Accredited programs shall be admitted as Members of the Computing Professionals Body.
7. A scheme should be proposed to induct current computing professionals to become members of this body.
8. Propose categories of memberships, and specify criteria for becoming member in each category

Agenda Item no. 7 Software to manage Accreditation and Evaluation of Programs

Members agreed that software should be developed in-house for managing accreditation and evaluation of computing programs. It should be generic so that it could also be useful for other Councils. **This may be started by hiring one computing professional, who can prepare software requirements and also take care of the website of NCEAC.**

Agenda Item no. 8 Renaming of Program from BS (IT) to BS (CS) by KICSIT

The council did not approve change of name of the already visited BS (IT) program of KICSIT, because the program evaluation was conducted on the basis of it being BS (Information Technology) program and not as BS (Computer Science) Program.

Agenda Item no. 9 Purchasing of Accounting Software

Purchasing of accounting software for use by the Council secretariat was approved; at minimum available cost/price.

Agenda Item no. 10 Approval of new Program Evaluators

The following committee was constituted to approve additional Program Evaluators:

The Council suggested the following process/criteria guideline:

- a) An application form should be developed, to be filled by each candidate. The filled form should be submitted to NCEAC along with a brief CV.
- b) Opinion of existing Program Evaluators working in the same city may be obtained to assess applicant's reputation as a computing professional
- c) Minimum Qualifications must be a PhD degree in relevant field
- d) At least five years post-PhD experience, and at least three years teaching experience.
