Agenda Item no. 7 Honorarium of Program Evaluators

The Council approved to raise the amount of honorarium paid to program evaluators from Rs 5,000 to Rs 10,000 per accreditation visit.

Agenda Item no. 9 Issuance of NOC & Zero Visit of New programs

The Council agreed to issue No Objection Certificates (NOC) to launch new computing programs, but only after conducting a **ZERO VISIT** of the institute. Only one Senior Program Evaluator should go for Zero visit. Whereas fee for an accreditation visit is Rs 150,000, the **fee** for **Zero visit was approved to be Rs. 75,000**.

Council decided to also introduce **INTERIM VISIT** for those batches, which are yet to be accredited. The interim visit will be conducted during the third year of the program. Only one senior Program Evaluator should go for an Interim visit. The fee for an Interim visit was approved to be Rs 100,000.

It was also decided that the existing evaluation Performa will be used till new Zero and Interim visit Performa are approved.

Agenda Item no. 10 Distance Education Programs

The Chairperson informed the council that HEC is considering to develop a mechanism to accredit distant education degree programs offered by AIOU, Virtual University and COMSATS.

Agenda Item no. 11 3rd Program Evaluators Workshop

Members agreed to organize a workshop for Program Evaluators, to be conducted by a foreign resource person in the current year (2016-17).

Agenda Item no. 12 Service Structure of NCEAC Secretariat

The two-member committee formed to select candidates for appointment (agenda item no.8) shall also give its recommendation to the Council on this matter.

Agenda Item no. 13 Any new matter with the permission of Chair

- a. There was a consensus that NCEAC Council meetings should preferably be held either on Thursday or Friday. These days are convenient for most of the members to attend Council meetings.
- b. It was also decided that, in future, comments will be added in the category letters to inform the institute about the deficiencies.
- c. It was decided that, if institute desires to accredit one of their passed out batch, they should apply separately for this.
- d. It was decided that, NCEAC will organize an international conference. In this regard Dr Jamil Ahmad Vice Chancellor Abasyn University is to be requested to execute and further process the conference proposal.
- e. On the recommendation of HEC, it was decided that NCEAC will not send its accreditation team to an affiliated institute, until the same program of the affiliating university has been accredited by NCEAC.
